

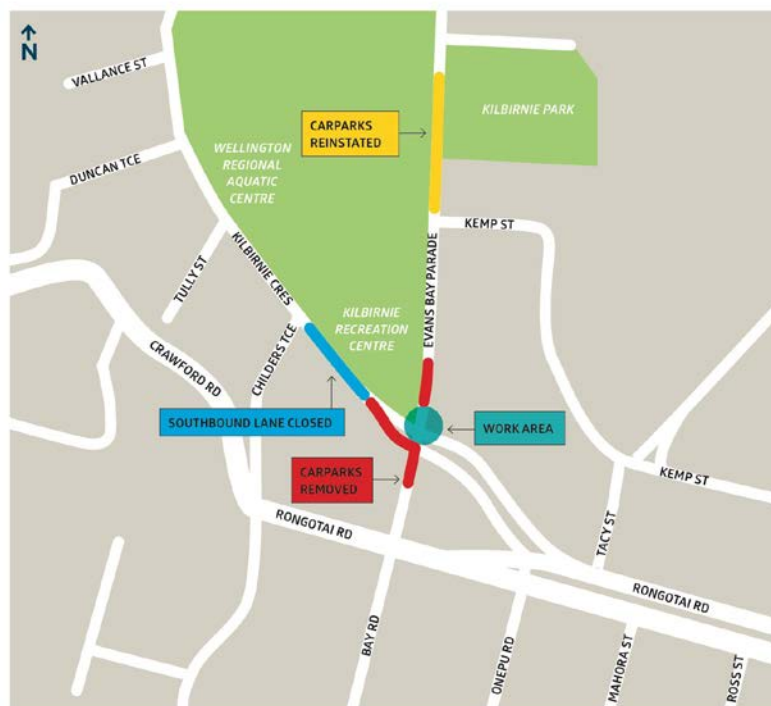

## Kilbirnie West Stormwater Upgrade - Update

Dear Residents and Business Owners,

Thank you for your support as our stormwater upgrade work has progressed along Evans Bay Parade. Since work began in March 2018, 140m of 1.2m wide pipe has been laid in the ground. We are now approaching the intersection with Kilbirnie Crescent.

At current pipe laying rates, we expect to be working through the Evans Bay Parade/Kilbirnie Crescent intersection on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2018. This means that on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June local road diversions will be in place, which will be clearly signposted both throughout the work site and surrounding roads.

This means that:

- The 15 car parks in Evans Bay Parade, next to the sports field will be reinstated and available for parking (shown in yellow). This should alleviate the temporary removal of five car parks located in Kilbirnie Crescent and Evans Bay Parade (shown in red).
- The southbound lane in Kilbirnie Crescent will be closed from the Kilbirnie Library to the intersection (shown in blue).

We expect to be working in this area for approximately four weeks. One of our tasks is to remove a large concrete slab from under the road. It's likely that dealing with this concrete may be noisy at times, but we will do our best to minimise disruption.

Once through the Evans Bay Parade and Kilbirnie Crescent intersection we will continue to work towards the intersection of Rongatai Road and Bay Road; we'll keep you updated as we move southwards.

Thank you for your continued patience as we work to improve stormwater flow and help reduce flooding risk in Kilbirnie.
