

Likely Fees and Voluntary Donations for 2019

(These will be confirmed by our Board of Trustees later this year).

1. Activity and Resources Donation: \$400 per student or \$500 per family

This donation helps us to pay for:

- Additional resources in all teaching subjects
- Additional resources for sports including paying for our Director of Sport
- Cultural experiences for our students
- Managing and upgrading our IT network
- Data projectors, computers, speakers and security cameras
- Music, physical education and outdoor education equipment
- Classroom and other furniture

2. Special Character and Stakeholder Donation \$500 per family

This donation goes to:

- Board of Proprietors for Property and Special Character (College Priest, Chaplaincy Assistant, Ministry Team and Chapel costs) - \$270
- Retreats - \$50
- National Network of Marist Schools Levy - \$20
- The St Patrick's College Foundation (The Foundation supports a range of extra opportunities that we provide including additional staff, professional development, sports and cultural activities) - \$110
- The Old Boys Association - \$30
- The Parents' Association - \$20

3. Other Fees and Donations:

These will vary for every student:

- Student diary and ID card - \$20
- NZQA fees are required for all students who are doing NCEA courses. The current cost is \$76.70 or \$20 if a family has a community services card and completes the NZQA Application for Financial Assistance
- Music Tuition - \$200 donation
- Sports Registration fees vary from \$40 to \$110
- Optional Workbooks for some subjects
- Some subjects such as Art, Technology and Outdoor Education ask for a materials donation to help cover the additional costs associated with that particular subject.
- Optional College Magazine: The Patrician - \$27

4. Attendance Dues:

Attendance Dues are a compulsory payment to the Archdiocese of Wellington. The cost of Attendance Dues in 2018 was \$995 per student.
